

CONDITIONS OF A SCHOLARSHIP

1. **Grant of the Scholarship:** A Scholarship is granted at the sole discretion of the Stamford Endowed Schools (The School).

- 1.1 Candidates may be entered for one or more the categories of Scholarship: Academic, Art, Music, Drama and Sport (depending upon year of entry). Owing to the expectations of Scholars, Scholarships may not be held in both Music and Sport, other combinations are permitted.

- 1.2 Candidates gaining more than one Scholarship will be known as a Scholar in each category.

2. **Obligations of the pupil:** Scholars are required to work hard, to contribute positively to the life of the School, to be a credit to the School and to set a good example to other pupils. The pupil must adhere to the School's required standards of conduct and progress. These are the **Purposes of the Scholarship**.

- 2.1 Academic Scholars are not only expected to produce outstanding work but to set standards and provide academic leadership for their contemporaries in the School. They will actively participate in the Scholarship programme. An annual review is held, and all Scholarships are renewable subject to satisfactory performance. It is expected that academic Scholars will be capable, if they so wish, of proceeding to Oxford, Cambridge or another top university, after their time at Stamford Endowed schools.

- 2.2 Pupils who are awarded a Scholarship are expected, under normal circumstances to continue at the Stamford Endowed Schools through to the completion of Year 13.

3. **Obligations of the parent(s):** The parents are required to:

- 3.1 return the Scholarship Application Form and required accompanying documentation by the due date, and:

- 3.2 support and encourage the pupil to achieve the Purposes of the Scholarships, and

- 3.3 treat members of the School community reasonably and uphold the aims and the good name of the School; and

- 3.4 comply with the School's Terms and conditions.

4. **Termination of the Scholarship:** The Scholarship may be terminated on the following grounds:
- 4.1 termination on the grounds of conduct:** The School may terminate the Scholarship by written notice sent to the parents with immediate effect if, in the opinion of the School Governors acting in good faith, one or more of the following conditions have not been fulfilled.
- 4.2** the pupil has not complied with the obligations set out in clause 2 and in the further opinion of the Governors, there has been no significant improvement following consultation with the parents and/or the pupil and the issue of a written warning.
5. **Conditions of Scholarship:** These conditions of Scholarship take precedence over any of the School's *Terms and Conditions* which are inconsistent with them but in all other respects, the School's *Terms and Conditions* as amended from time to time shall apply and these conditions of Scholarship shall be interpreted in accordance with them.
