Session	Cost	Timings	Funding
Core Day	£62.00	08:00 – 16:00	Working Family Funding can be applied to these sessions.
Morning only	£40	08:00 – 13:00	Funding to be discussed if necessary.
Early Start	£5.25	07:45 – 08:00	Funding cannot be claimed before 08:00.
Late Finish	£8.00	16:00 – 17:00	Additional Billing
Evening care (including tea)	£10.00	17:00 – 18:00	Additional Billing
Stamford Enhanced Provision (SEP)	£20 per day*		* Only payable if Working Family Funding is applied.

2-3-year-olds contracts and funding criteria:

- All Year-Round contracts only
- Minimum booking of **two** days per week at the setting
- 24 hours of Working Family Funding (WFF) can be applied to three, 8-hour sessions per week from 08:00 – 16:00
- Additional sessions will be billed at the standard rate (sessions from **07:45-08:00, 16:00 – 17:00 and 17:00 – 18:00 if required**)
- SEP will be payable on each day or part-day where WFF is applied

Example A	3 x core days (08:00 – 16:00)	24 hours of funding can be applied	3 x Late Care sessions at £8.00 = £24 3 x SEP at £20 = £60	£84
Example B	4 x core days (08:00 – 16:00)	No funding	No additional hours	£248
Example C	5 x core days (08:00 – 16:00)	24 hours of funding can be applied	2 x Core Day sessions at £62.00 a day = £124 3 x SEP at £20 = £60	£184

- The onsite Stamford School Nursing team, in addition to Nursery and Preschool staff who are Paediatric First Aid trained.
- All meals and snacks are cooked on site, with allergy champions within the school catering team (Holroyd Howe)
- Separate dining room for mealtimes, encouraging social development and ensuring a safe and allergy-aware mealtime experience

Additional Items:

Late Charges:

- Late collection during opening hours will incur a charge at the hourly rate of the next session. i.e. if a Badger is booked for a core day 08:00 – 16:00, but the adult arrives at 16:25, the full late care price of £8.00 will apply.
- Collection after 18:00 will be charged at £10 per 15 minutes or part thereof to cover staff costs.
