The Stamford Card?

The Stamford Card is a loyalty card that allows holders to access special offers at local businesses across Stamford.

Who Uses the Card?

The Stamford Card is popular among residents and visitors who value local shopping, dining, and experiences and want to support the fabulous Stamford high street.

Since its relaunch in 2023, the scheme has grown to nearly 200 active cardholders. Each contributing £10-£50 per month, with all proceeds supporting the Stamford School Bursary Fund.
