Fundraising Old Stamfordian

Christine Bennett (OS 69)
has informed us of her
fundraising project for the
charity 'Herts Musical
Memories', with <u>a YouTube</u>
playlist for her 70th birthday.

Christine told us:

"It took a little while to sort out – but, again, people were astonishingly generous.

Some of the videos are endearingly amateur but some are extremely professional (not least, because most of those are from professional musicians, who – even though they were



in the midst of a time when earning was

almost impossible — *still* gave their time for free). This time the charity is <u>Herts Musical Memories</u> ("HMM") I'm not one of the "leaders" but I'm a regular "support singer" for them, so I saw how desolate the clients were, a few years ago, when the *Singing for the Brain* (TM) sessions, run by the Alzheimer's Society were about to be halted because of a funding change. HMM was set up by one of the leaders that lives up the road from me, and was able to rescue about a dozen of the 14 or so groups in Hertfordshire, and she runs it on a shoestring from her home. It's entirely reliant on *ad hoc* grants and donations and the modest contributions from the clients."
