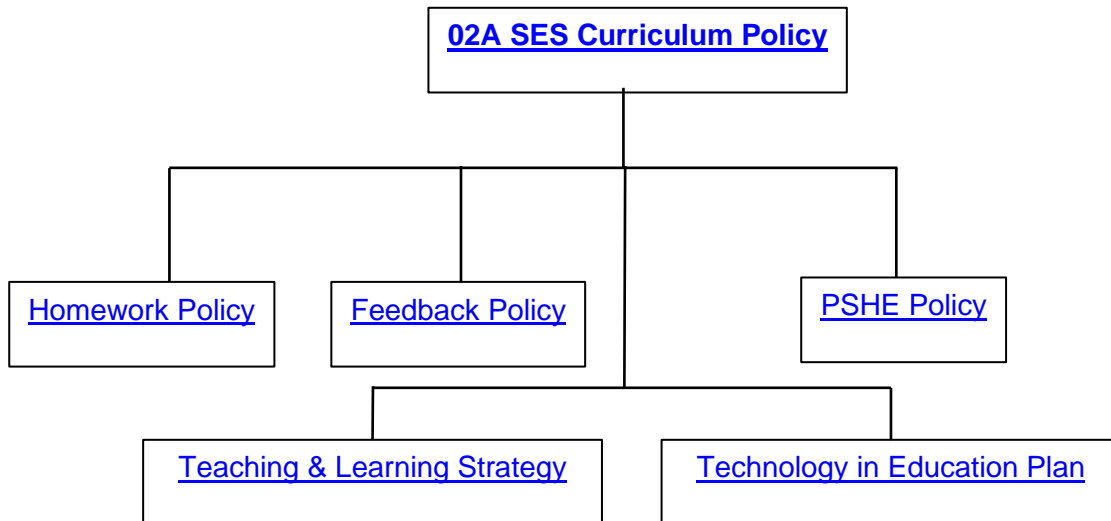

SES Curriculum Policy

The [Curriculum Policy](#) outlines the school's vision and aims and is underpinned by 8 supporting policies. Further details of all of these can be obtained by clicking on the relevant link below.



Reporting and Assessment

Pupil progress is reported regularly to parents in a number via the Short Report, the Full Report and Parent Consultation Evenings. Timings for individual year groups across SS and SHS are agreed to within a week and agreed areas of comment are common across the senior schools. A Calendar of Reporting and Assessment for each school is produced by the Deputy Heads Academic.

All reporting is done electronically using iSAMS. Parent Consultation Evenings are scheduled to support the regular flow of information between school and home.

Reports in all year groups include an assessment of a student's Approach to Learning, which is assessed using the following statements.

Ambition, e.g. setting high personal expectations, striving to improve, following up on opportunities for independent study, working beyond the set curriculum, undertaking wider reading and additional problems, resilience, enthusiasm.

Reflection, e.g. learning from experience, acting on feedback given, seeking help where necessary, develop and adapt their learning styles, thinking flexibly, listening to, working with and being respectful of other people and their views.

Diligence, e.g. striving for accuracy, taking an active part in the lesson, completing homework to a high personal standard, persistence, following tasks through to completion, punctual, good behaviour, good personal organisation, being properly equipped for lessons, meeting deadlines.

The Approach to Learning of each student is assessed and reported on using the following scale:

	Excellent Approach to Learning
	Good Approach to Learning
	Secure Approach to Learning
	Concern with Approach to Learning
	Serious Concern with Approach to Learning

In a Short Report, Priority Focus Areas for development are identified and in a Full Report or at Parent Consultation Evenings these are expanded with focussed, constructive advice given to students and their parents on how students can further develop.

Attainment Grades are awarded using a nine-point scale. In Y7-9 this should be the Attainment Grade at which pupils are currently working and is relative to that particular year group. In Y10 to Y13 these are Predicted Grades and should use the appropriate International GCSE, GCSE, A level or BTEC letter and number grades.

The Attainment and Predicted Grades given by teachers are compared with the indicator grades generated by GL CAT4 testing so that students and their parents know and understand whether a student is performing at, below or above the expected grade of someone with a similar profile nationally.

In Y10 to Y13 the Predicted Grades that students are awarded use the same scales as the external qualifications that they are working towards and these are compared with the GL CAT4 indicator grades.

Coursework and / or Non-Examined Assessments

Many subjects include elements of coursework and/or non-examined assessment within their GCSE, A level specifications. These allow candidates to demonstrate skills which could not be assessed in an examination and encourage a more individual investigative approach.

We expect pupils to gain from the opportunities that coursework gives them to:

- become more deeply involved in some part of the work which particularly interests them;
- pursue some individual research and develop their own ideas;
- demonstrate skills beyond those which are tested in examinations;
- demonstrate excellence by producing work of quality and depth;
- improve their likely attainment by committing themselves to careful preparation of assessed coursework.

These advantages and the importance of coursework in assessment for external examinations mean that such opportunities should be provided for pupils throughout the curriculum. Schemes of work must therefore include suitable opportunities for teachers to employ coursework or project approaches.

The time that our pupils devote to coursework is very variable; some will commit themselves with dedication aiming to reach a high standard while others will make a late start to the work and will consequently put themselves under pressure to complete it in a last-minute rush. This is of particular concern because it makes it difficult for the pupil to meet the demands made by his/her other subjects. Departments must keep a careful check upon the time spent on such activities and set interim deadlines to assist pupils in their organisation.

Although subjects will make different demands in terms of coursework, and will necessarily require different approaches, the general responsibilities of Heads of Department include:

- selecting an appropriate topic or focus for the work;
- informing the Deputy Heads Academic, well in advance, about the timing of such work, so that they can maintain some overview of the particular demands which coursework is making on pupils;
- ensuring that pupils understand the task, how it is to be assessed, and what portion of the overall assessment is represented by each particular task;
- ensuring that pupils tackle the work in an appropriate manner;
- setting clear and reasonable deadlines (for extended pieces of work this would include deadlines which relate to various stages of partial completion);
- ensuring wherever possible that deadlines are kept to by departmental staff;
- informing Head of Year/ Deputy Heads Academic (as appropriate), when pupils fail to act properly over any aspect of coursework;
- establishing appropriate procedures for completion of coursework in accordance with the requirements of the examination boards;
- ensuring that pupils are aware of the appropriate regulations for completion of coursework in accordance with the requirements of the examination boards;
- ensuring that coursework is stored safely and securely;
- establishing appropriate procedures for the marking and moderation of coursework in accordance with the requirements of the examination boards;
- ensuring that, where appropriate, work from both sites is sent to the same moderator;
- completing any paperwork required by the boards in respect of the coursework entry;
- when setting deadlines, being mindful of pupils wishing to appeal before coursework is submitted to the examination board;
- following the relevant SES examinations policy on coursework.

Internal Examinations

In Y7 students will sit exams in the core subjects of English, Maths, Science and French / Spanish. In Y8 students will sit exams in the core subjects of English, Maths, Biology, Chemistry, Physics and French / Spanish plus Geography, History and Philosophy & Ethics. In Y9 and Y10 all pupils will sit formal examinations in all academic subjects. Mock examinations for Y11 take place immediately after Christmas and those for Y13 are scheduled for after the February half-term.

The advantages of such an arrangement are:

- the results provide feedback to teachers which can be interpreted for pupils and parents in an open, transparent and positive way without being seen as negatives;
- Y10 and Y12 internal exams provide an important milestone at which to assess progress being the mid-point of the examination courses.
- Heads of Department and subject teachers are expected to make whatever arrangements are appropriate to ensure that pupils are ready to sit external papers, the mock examinations are part of that process.

Heads of Departments should ensure that:

- papers are 'fair' to and accessible for pupils in all sets;
- all pupils receive a clear indication of what is to be included in the examination with advice about revision techniques and examination techniques as appropriate;
- where appropriate, sufficient steps are taken so that pupils are not able to deduce in advance which external past papers are being used;
- papers are accurately worded and clearly reproduced;
- procedures exist for consistent marking across all sets;
- scripts are returned, correct answers are provided, appropriate teaching points are made, and the marking scheme is explained;
- concerns which arise over the poor performance of particular pupils should be passed to tutors and Head of Year;
- where appropriate, a re-test may be considered, not as a punishment but where it would be educationally beneficial to that student;
- continuing records of examination performance within the department are maintained.

Where a pupil qualifies for a concession in external examinations, where practicable s/he should be given the same allowance in internal examinations.

External Examinations

GCSE, International GCSE, A level, AS and BTEC examinations are taken with five examination boards: AQA, CAIE, Edexcel, Eduqas and OCR. Heads of Department are allowed to choose the specifications, and to select to teach particular units which offer the content and the forms of assessment which in their opinion best suit our pupils. These decisions should be made in consultation with the Deputy Heads Academic. See summary pages at the end of the handbook for further detail.

All the work concerned with entering pupils for examinations and with the conduct of the examinations is controlled by the Examination Officer. Ensuring correct entries where teaching is across sites requires close co-operation by Heads of Department.

Pupils with a specific learning difficulty or disability may qualify for examination concessions such as a time allowance or access to a word processor or reader. This may depend upon a report from an outside consultant which is submitted to the board. This work is overseen by the Heads of Learning Support.

Data Relating to Pupil Potential

Both SS and SHS use baseline data provided by GL Assessments, based on CAT4 testing and PASS surveys

CAT4 (Cognitive Abilities Test)

The CAT4 testing system is run by GL Assessment, is a comprehensive and objective test of a student's developed abilities – those that, in part, determine attainment and can be built upon and developed to improve outcomes. For example, verbal reasoning can be developed by supporting a student's reading, comprehension and vocabulary.

The main focus of each individual report is to inform teachers, students and their parents and carers about an individual's underlying ability and how this can be recognised and built upon to ensure that a student achieves his or her potential.

The results provide a benchmark and may be used very effectively as part of a review of a student's performance alongside other information including teacher assessment and school data on aspects such as attendance, additional needs, EAL status, etc. CAT4 provides indicators (NOT PREDICTIONS) of attainment for KS2, KS3, GCSE and AS/A level which can provide a starting point for target setting. It is this aspect of the CAT4 that is particularly sensitive, and we are currently discussing how best to use these indicators. GL CAT4 results are nationally standardised; there is no Independent sector standardisation.

Baseline data is used in four ways: summative value-added analysis, formative analysis and tracking, year on year, baseline comparisons and analysis of a pupil's individual strengths and areas for development.

Summative

In-house value-added analysis is provided after the results of GCSE/International GCSE and A levels. The data (i.e. the residuals from a regression line) show whether individual pupils matched the average performance of other pupils with the same input score, exceeded it or fell short of it. By aggregating the data, performance measures are produced for sets, for subjects and for the whole school.

This *post hoc* analysis allows us to examine results in a way that removes the effect of a pupil's prior learning and therefore emphasises the impact of the teaching and learning during the course. The analysis allows us to identify areas of above and below expected achievement. This prompts a discussion of possible reasons, celebration of success, sharing of best practice and improving performance for future year groups.

The summative value-added analysis of a department's performance forms part of the evaluation of the work of that department.

Formative

By applying the subject regression lines to information about present pupils, we can make estimates of performance for pupils currently on GCSE/International GCSE, AS or A level courses and use these estimates to aid our tracking of pupil performance. Heads of Department can use this performance data to make targeted interventions where appropriate.

Baseline Comparisons

The data provided by baseline testing can be used to compare standards of pupils at entry year by year as can the standardised scores which form part of the schools' admissions procedures.

Individual Pupil Analysis

The individual strand data provided by a baseline test (vocabulary, mathematics, perceptual skills and non-verbal skills) can be used to aid teachers in their analysis of pupil performance and the provision of differentiated tasks.
